




Top Shipping School Research Rankings 2011-2013

Shipping refers to cargo movement between two or more geographic locations in all transport modes. It is a global industry closely linked with global trade. Shipping research has grown significantly in recent years. Researchers have devoted effort to advance the knowledge frontier of shipping studies as well as the theoretical foundation. Scholarly journal publications are important to facilitate knowledge sharing among researchers and practitioners. This report provides the latest information on the top shipping school rankings in the world.

By tracking publications on shipping studies under the category “Transportation”, we examine research on shipping and shipping-related topics captured in Thomson Reuters’ database of *ISI Web of Science* between 2011 and 2013. This report provides information on: (1) number of shipping articles published between 2011 and 2013, (2) key journals publishing shipping research outputs, and (3) worldwide rankings of shipping schools.

To begin, we conducted a search of the Citation Report in the *ISI Web of Science* to identify shipping-related articles published between 2011 and 2013 under the category of “Transportation”. We found that there are 307 such articles as follows:

According to the *ISI Web of Science*, ten key journals published shipping articles between 2011 and 2013. These journals accounted for 85% of the total shipping research outputs in 2011-13 (i.e., 261 out of 307 articles):
