Abstract:

The Inclusive Wealth Index (IWI) is a new economic index presented in the Inclusive Wealth Report 2012, which was launched in the United Nations Conference on Sustainable Development (Rio+20) in 2012. The report originally covered only 20 countries, but the 2014 version, which was released in December 2014, substantially expanded the scope of analysis to 140 countries. Future of maritime depends how it contributes to sustainability in terms for their profitability and in the same time its environmental values. I will discuss IWI related to maritime industry.

Bio:

Professor Managi has been awarded several national research grants on topics such as urbanization, transportation, energy, climate change, sustainability, and population change. He has received several research fellowships from organizations such as the *Helmholtz Association and Cheney Senior Fellowship* and has served as an expert on energy and environmental policy. He is a lead author for IPCC, a coordinating lead author for *the Intergovernmental Platform on Biodiversity and Ecosystem Services (IPBES)*, a director for *Inclusive Wealth*

Report 2016 (IWR 2016), an editor of Environmental Economic and Policy Studies, and on the editorial board for six journals including Resource and Energy Economics.

He is the author of 23 books and 170 academic journal papers, including *Science, Global Environmental Change, Journal of Economic Behavior & Organization, Journal of Environmental Economics and Management, Journal of Banking and Finance, Journal of Economic Dynamics and Control, Land Economics, Environmental and Resource Economics, Journal of Regulatory Economics, Resource and Energy Economics, The Energy Journal, International Journal of Production Economics, Omega, Energy Economics, Environment and Development Economics, Ecological Economics, Economic Modelling, Agricultural Economics, Journal of Industrial Ecology, Energy Policy, and Physica A.*
